Window blinds kill a child every 2 weeks, yet manufacturers and consumers remain unaware of the danger. We want to inform and educate in order to ensure that no more children die due to window blinds. This brochure helps you assess the safety of your home and daycare. Please use the suggested safety checklist on the inside and make sure your child is safe.

Read this!**

Suggested Safety Checklist

Don't be afraid to ask the hard questions. Your child's life may depend on it. Don't take "I don't know" for an answer. Please seek to find the truth. This checklist will help.

Safety Questions Check if Yes

Check References. Were any of the references negative?

Has this daycare had its licensed revoked or have received any violations?

Is the daycare license out of date?

Are there any convicted felons working or living in the daycare facility?

Are there window blinds present anywhere?

Safety Questions Check if Yes

Are any electrical sockets uncovered?

Are any medications or vitamins visible or unsecured?

Are any poisons or flammables visible or unsecured?

Are there any appliances or tall furniture that could fall over?

Are any Choking hazards present?

Are Safety gates not used where needed or left open?

Are the cribs unsafe? See www.cpsc.gov for details

Is there too much bedding (suffocation hazard/ SIDS danger) ?

Safety Questions Check if Yes

Is there any broken playground equipment or open water in playground?

Is the play area not fully fenced in, or is the surface hard?

Are strangulation hazards present (ropes, chains, toy strings, cords etc.)?

Are sharp objects present or accessible by a child?

Is there any unsecured fencing around daycare?

Is the daycare unlocked or easily entered?

Are recalled toys present?

Are there any other dangers or concerns you have with the facility?

If any boxes are checked "yes" Please discuss with Daycare provider to remedy all issues
